1. **Take a look at:** To look at or examine something. It's a friendly and casual way to suggest someone look at something.
2. **Take place:** To occur or happen, usually referring to scheduled or organized events.
3. **Take advantage of:** To use an opportunity for personal gain, whether positive (benefiting everyone) or negative (exploiting someone or a situation).
4. **Take a risk:** To engage in something that involves possible danger or negative outcomes.
5. **Take over:** To gain control or responsibility for something, especially when it involves dominance or control.
6. **Take part in:** To participate or join in an activity, project, or event.
7. **Take something into account:** To consider or remember an important factor or detail when making a decision or doing something.
8. **To be taken into custody:** Usually passive, this refers to being arrested or held by authorities.
9. **Take a holiday/vacation/ time off:** To have leisure time away from work or routine responsibilities.
10. **Take photos of:** To use a camera to capture images. Also, the action of having someone else photograph you.
11. **Take on something/someone:** To face, deal with, or confront a challenge, task, or opponent.
12. **Take the time to do something:** To allocate or dedicate time specifically for doing something.
